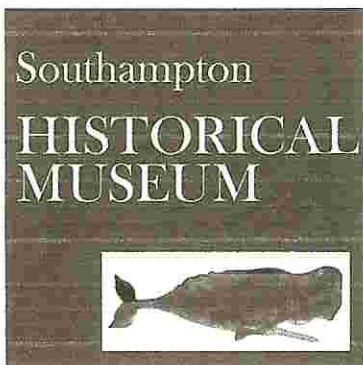

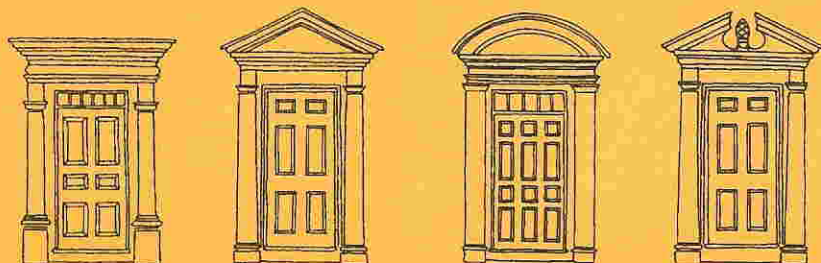

Turn right at the stop sign, and 217 Cedar Street will be 1,500 feet up on your right, with a clearly marked mailbox and a red roof. Park on Cedar Street, making sure not to block the driveway, which is shared.*
